There is a almost new snowblower here for you to use. Must be able to remove snow and salt the sidewalks .

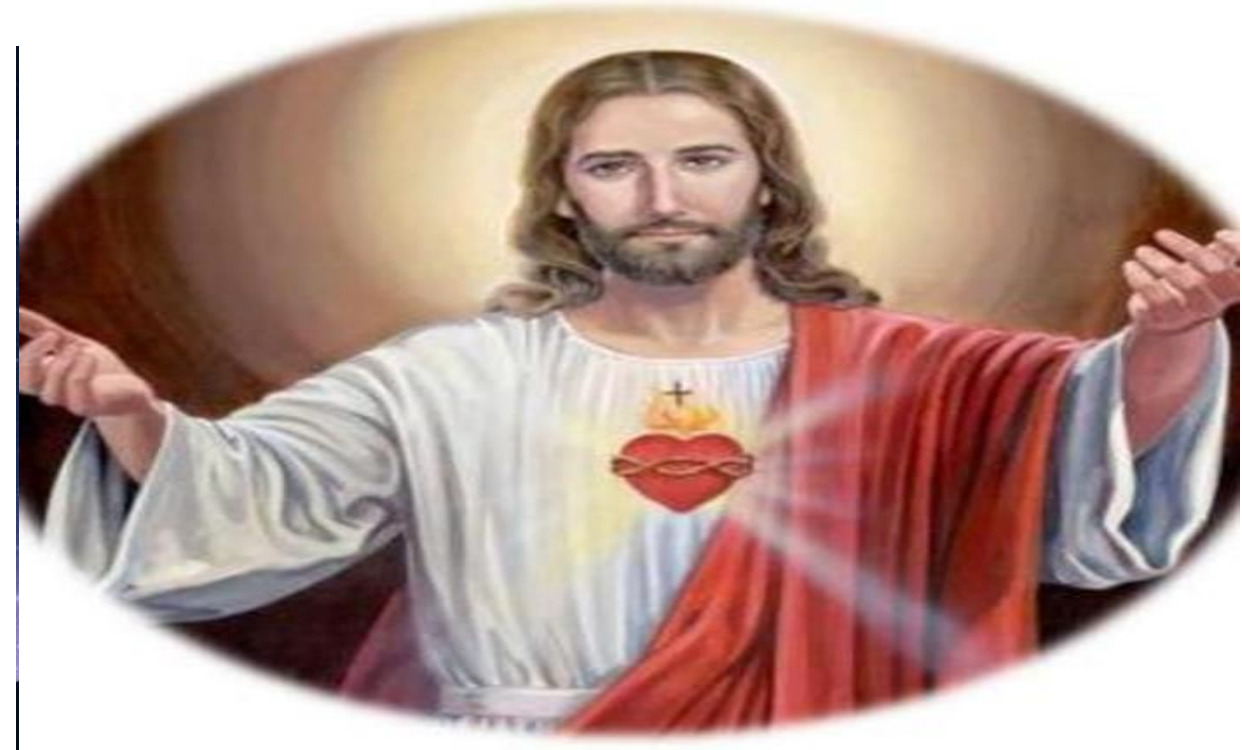
